Fresh Horizons goes international

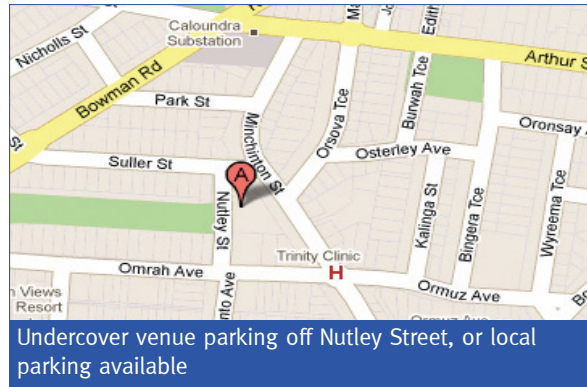
